


“I am thankful to God for allowing me to share with you about our burden. This book has been very useful for our Sunday School classes since the 1960s. Along with our American missionaries, our parents and second-generation Christians made use of it as their main resource book for their spiritual growth. Personally, when my siblings and I were young, my Mom would always read this book to us before we went to bed. We enjoyed it; in fact, it shaped my basic theological knowledge. Many others from my generation who have read this book have a great passion for, and a good foundation in, Christian belief. We are convinced that this book will be very helpful for our people and younger generations, at a time when we are facing high rates of nominal Christianity and a need for basic Bible knowledge and Christian education.

We plan to distribute this book to all the Lai speaking churches in Myanmar, which includes sixteen associations in the Chin Association for Christian Communication (CACC) who have more than 150 Lai speaking churches. The Sangawi Printing Ministry, composed of Immanuel Baptist Church of Hakha, Thantlang Baptist Church, Johnson Memorial Baptist Church, and Thantlang Centenary Baptist Church, would like to take responsibility for reprinting this book.
